

## Kindergarten Frequently Asked Questions

### How old does my child need to be in order to register for Kindergarten?

- To be eligible to attend kindergarten in the 2018-19 school year, your child must turn five years old on or before December 31, 2018.

### When is the kindergarten program available?

- The kindergarten program follows the regular school calendar but may commence later in September and finish earlier in June. For the 2018-19 school year kindergarten options, please see the following chart or contact the Clearview [school in your area](#).

### What will my child learn?
