

# Administrative Procedure 206 - Gender Identity, Sexual Orientation and Human Sexuality Topics

### Background

The Division will provide gender identity, sexual orientation and human sexuality instruction as mandated through the grades 4 through 6 Health Program, the grades 7 through 9 Health and Personal Life Skills Program and Senior High School Life Management (CALM 20 Course).

In accordance with the Education Act Section 58.1 and Ministerial Order 028/2024, parents/guardians must be notified and must provide written consent before a student receives formal instruction on human sexuality education.

#### **Procedures**

- 1. Parent Notification and Consent
  - 1.1. Principals shall ensure parents are notified at least 30 calendar days in advance of any planned instruction specifically addressing gender identity, sexual orientation, or human sexuality.
  - 1.2. Written notification must include:
    - The grade(s) and subject(s) in which the topics will be addressed
    - The scheduled date(s) of instruction
    - The name(s) of the teacher(s) providing instruction
    - The Opt-In Form (School Engage)
  - 1.3. Notification may be communicated via:
    - School/Class newsletter or formal parent letter
    - School website
    - Direct distribution of Form 206-1 (Through School Engage)

## 2. Opt-In Requirement

- 2.1. Instruction on these topics may only proceed for students whose parents/guardians have returned a completed Opt-In form (Form 206-1).
- 2.2. Consent is valid only for the school year in which it is given. New consent is required annually.
- 2.3. Absence of a completed Opt-In form shall be treated as non-consent.

## 3. Alternative Learning

3.1. Students who do not Opt-In must be provided with meaningful alternative learning

activities that are educationally appropriate and supervised.

3.2. No academic penalty shall result from not participating in the human sexuality instruction.

#### 4. Resources

- 4.1. Principals must ensure that all resources used for instruction in gender identity, sexual orientation, or human sexuality:
  - Are aligned with Alberta Education's Programs of Study
  - Are authorized by the Minister of Education
- 4.2. External presenters or third-party resources may only be used if both the materials and the individuals have received explicit Ministerial approval.

#### 5. Incidental Classroom Discussion

5.1. The Opt-In requirement does not apply to incidental or spontaneous classroom discussions on topics of gender identity, sexual orientation, or human sexuality that are not part of planned instruction.
