Leadership Highlights

- During the board meeting on November 28, 2024, Superintendent Scot Leys reported on a variety of leadership activities that have significantly shaped the direction and operations of Clearview Public Schools:
 - Staff Leadership and Development: The Leadership Learning Team (LLT) engaged in an Emergency Preparedness Table Top exercise and workshops on Progressive Staff Accountability and Digging into Data, enhancing the division's capabilities in critical response and data-driven decision-making.
 - Data Analysis and Professional Development: A focus on Alberta Education Assurance Measures, Early Years
 Screeners, and Literacy Data was presented, showcasing efforts to track educational outcomes. Professional
 development activities featured a Coaching Workshop with Stu Henry and participation in the CASS Conference,
 discussing AI use in school divisions and collegiate education pathways.
 - Community Engagement: Highlights included the Trustee School Visits and the "Dads at the Doors" initiative at SES.

There was also a presentation by K. Syson & S. Quapp, from Stettler Elementary School emphasizing the division's commitment to inclusive education practices.

Policy Updates and Approvals

Several policy adjustments were made, including the Clearview Star Awards and Purchasing Oversight policies, ensuring that operational standards are maintained and align with the division's goals.

Financial Update:

Secretary-Treasurer Reyes reviewed and sought approval of audited financial statements, underscoring the board's commitment to transparency and accountability. Discussions also spanned budget revisions, critical technology enhancements, and the strategic allocation of reserve funds aimed at bolstering future educational initiatives and infrastructure.

Annual Education Results and Exam Performance Insights 2023-24

Clearview Public Schools has released its Annual Education Results Report and assessment outcomes for the 2023-24 school year, marking significant achievements and areas for strategic improvement.

Key Highlights from the Annual Education Results:

• Academic Achievement: Literacy and numeracy initiatives have been strengthened, showing positive trends in student performance across all tested grades. Targeted professional development in literacy and numeracy is ongoing.

PAT and Diploma Exam Insights:

- Provincial Achievement Tests (PAT): Clearview showed stable or improved results, particularly in Grade 9, with most courses trending upwards in meeting the Acceptable Standard.
- Diploma Exams: Significant improvements were noted in the diploma exam results, with more students meeting the Acceptable Standard. Efforts to align School-Awarded Marks with Diploma Exam Marks are ongoing, especially in mathematics.
